Bow, wow, wow, whose dog art thou?



Lit - tle Tom - my Tuck - er's dog bow, wow, wow. (hop)

Formation: Children are in pairs. Each faces his/her partner. Partners are arranged in a circle.

Action: Sing and perform the following actions.

Bow, wow, wow - stamp three times (right, left, right)

Whose - clap hands

dog art thou? - point and wave index finger at partner.

Little Tommy Tucker's dog - partners clasp hands and quickly circle in place making only a half turn. (exchanging spots)

Bow, wow, wow - stamp three times (right, left, right)

(hop) - jump and turn 180-degrees in the air before landing. Participants are now facing new partners.

Repeat until each child has traveled around the circle.
