- Hold up two fingers and "beat" in the air.
- Hold up one finger and "beat" in the air.
- ▣ Move one arm in a "Come here!" manner.
- U Begin four beat (macrobeat) clapping pattern: pat legs, clap own hands, clap partner's hands - palms forward, clap own hands. Repeat.
- ▢ Depending on age of children either:
  1. Return to ○ and ▣ motions.
  2. Partners link right arms and walk around each other one time (walking "swing").
